Eligibility Criteria

The Andrew D. Washington Scholarship:

The applicant must:

- be a dependent of an AFSCME District Council 20 member
- be a high school senior
- be enrolled in a Historically Black College or University (HBCU)
- have a 2.5 GPA
- have 25 hours of certified community service within the last year.

The James Ivey Scholarship:

- be a dependent of an AFSCME District Council 20 member
- be a graduating high school senior or current college student
- be enrolled in a full-time degree-seeking program at either an accredited four-year or two-year institution
- have a 2.5 GPA

The James Ivey Scholarship was established for children and financially dependent grandchildren of full dues paying AFSCME District Council 20 members. The scholarship will be awarded to 2 recipients in the amount of \$1,000 each, that may be used for any field of study at any accredited four-year or two-year institution.
